Articulation programs

A TAFE NSW Articulation Program means your students can begin their studies without travelling abroad, and complete the course at a TAFE NSW campus in Australia.

A Pathway to Australian Education

An Articulation Program is a pre-arranged agreement between your organisation and TAFE NSW. With an Articulation Program, overseas curricular is assessed against the Australian Regulatory Standards to minimise overlap in course content.

Students already demonstrating competency in units that have been assessed against these Standards will be able to complete the course faster. They can commence study in their home country and move easily into a TAFE NSW higher education or Vocational Education and Training (VET) course.

Benefits to students

Students have the opportunity to:

- start studies in their home country
- simplify the process into a TAFE NSW course
- minimise costs to their study program
- experience living in another country
- benefit from Australia's education system, and
- return home with an Australian nationally recognised qualification.

Participating in an Articulation Program offers students a chance to expand their global network and gain a valuable international experience.

Dongguan Polytechnic, China

In 2024, TAFE NSW partnered with Dongguan Polytechnic in China. This Articulation Program enables students to pursue further studies of an Australian undergraduate degree upon a successful completion of the TAFE NSW Diploma of Accounting program, which is jointly offered by TAFE NSW and Dongguan Polytechnic in China.

King's Cornerstone International College, India

TAFE NSW established a new partnership with King's Cornerstone International College (KCIC) in India, to offer the Diploma of Hospitality Management. This partnership includes an articulation arrangement, creating a pathway for students who successfully complete the Diploma of Hospitality Management to continue their studies in Australia. These students will receive one year of credit towards the TAFE NSW Bachelor of Business (Specialising in Hospitality and Hotel Management), further enhancing their career prospects in the global hospitality industry.



Masterclass Training

TAFE NSW masterclass training actively engages and involves participants in their learning, through the use of roleplay, case studies, group work, and skills practice. Masterclasses can be delivered via connected platforms or in person, and at the completion of each masterclass, participants will receive a TAFE NSW certificate and transcript of study.

Lessons can be delivered with the support of an interpreter and bilingual materials, according to a student's training needs, and academic or industry prerequisites for masterclasses can vary.



Early Childhood Education and Care*

This range of specialised, five-day early childhood education and care masterclasses will address the growing demand for reform and standardisation. These masterclasses are arranged so that students can choose from 14 specific areas of early childhood education and care, to suit their business or educational needs.

3-day	Promoting wellbeing	Strategies to support psychological, physical, and social engagement for an aging population.
5-day	Assist with health issues – Diabetes	Understanding and supporting chronic health conditions and the multi-disciplinary approach to diabetes management.
5-day	Assist with daily living	Nutrition and effective self-care techniques for the older person.
5-day	Communicating with the older person and family	Effective communication techniques to promote a consultative and collaborative care program with families.
3-day	Caring for the person at end stage of life	Providing a holistic and supportive service at the end of a person's life.

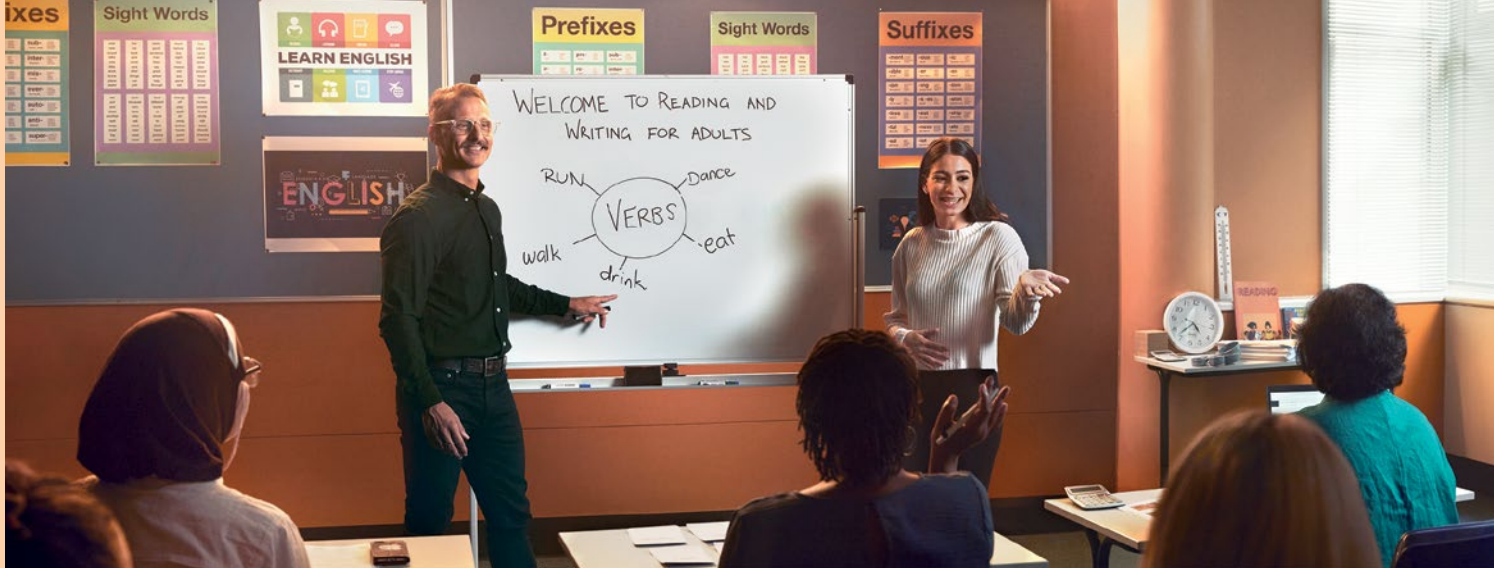


Professional Development*

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Third Party Agreements

TAFE NSW is committed to fostering global educational exchanges. We do this through our partnerships with other international education organisations. These exchanges offer your organisation the benefit of TAFE NSW specialised training and industry knowledge.

With our Third-Party Agreement Program, your organisation delivers part or all of a nationally recognised TAFE NSW qualification in your country. This means that students can gain a TAFE NSW education without the added expense of travelling overseas. Many of these programs include English language training before students embark on their courses of study.

Examples of our Programs

Fiji National University, Fiji



TAFE NSW has partnered with Fiji National University since 1998.

This program has allowed Fiji National University to provide cost-effective access to Australian qualifications to more than 7,000 students, contributing to a highly skilled workforce for Fiji.

Through the Third-Party Agreement Program, the university delivers TAFE NSW qualifications in many subject areas including:

- business
- hospitality management
- commercial cookery
- information technology
- travel and tourism management
- leadership and management, and
- human resource management.

Groworx, Philippines



TAFE NSW partnered with Groworx in the Philippines to address the shortage of aged-care, disability and healthcare workers.

Our Third-Party Agreement Program with Groworx focuses on training students in the Philippines to upskill them and prepare them for work in Regional NSW.

- no upfront costs

Shijiazhuang Vocational College of Technology and Information, China



In 2024, TAFE NSW established a partnership with Shijiazhuang Vocational College of Technology and Information in China, to jointly deliver the Diploma of Accounting.

This Third-Party Agreement Program combines the strengths of both institutions to deliver accounting education and training. This program provides students with qualifications that are recognised in both China and Australia.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Another type of Third-Party Agreement Program is recognition of prior learning.

This means where we provide students with credit for equivalent skills and knowledge attained at your institution and a pathway to a TAFE NSW qualification.

Recognition of prior learning is best suited to industry sectors that can be benchmarked to the Australian standards. It may be used to identify any training gaps between the qualifications for in-country gap training.

One example is with our partner in Nepal.

The Global Academy of Tourism and Hospitality Education (GATE), Nepal



Students studying at the Global Academy of Tourism and Hospitality Education may receive recognition of prior learning for their studies towards a TAFE NSW Certificate III in Commercial Cookery course.

Since the start of this program, over 70 students have graduated from this course with an Australian qualification without leaving their home country.



Study Tours

TAFE NSW Study Tours offer a wide variety of programs, either virtually or through in-person programs in Australia. Study tours are unique opportunities to get hands-on learning in Australian industries, and can be customised to suit your specific requirements. They offer participants the chance to gain valuable on-the-job skills, alongside a new cultural experience and global exposure.

TAFE NSW Study Tours cater to a wide range of in-demand sectors and course areas. Our in-person Study Tours are a great way for participants to get practical knowledge of Australian industries and valuable on-the-job training. We also offer virtual Study Tours across multiple disciplines, including our specialised English programs.

All Study Tours include a comprehensive orientation session and access to our student support facilities.

Three-day TAFE NSW VET online taster program

Our three-day, online course showcases the excellent delivery TAFE NSW provides for all vocational education and training (VET). Over each of the three days, the program consists of two, 2-hour sessions, totalling 12 hours in all.

The course teaches the Australian context of all the industry sectors represented.

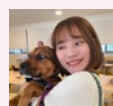
