

## Access Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop Applications



### Purpose




This Quick Reference Guide sets out the steps that TAFE NSW students can take to sign into the Adobe Creative Cloud desktop application on TAFE NSW devices to access Adobe Creative Cloud applications.



### Background

TAFE NSW students have access to the suite of Adobe Creative Cloud applications. A selection of these applications are installed on TAFE NSW computers to assist students with completing course work. Applications installed can vary between classrooms and campuses. Students can also access various Adobe Creative Cloud applications at TAFE NSW libraries.

### Access Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop Applications

<p>Login to the TAFE NSW computer with your TAFE NSW email (e.g. jane.citizen1@studytafensw.edu.au) and password.</p>	
<p>Open the <b>Start Menu</b>, click <b>All</b> then click <b>Adobe Creative Cloud</b>.</p>

<p>Enter your TAFE NSW email address (e.g. jane.citizen1@studytafensw.edu.au) then click <b>Continue</b>.</p>	
<p>When prompted with the TAFE NSW portal sign in page, enter your TAFE NSW username (e.g. jane.citizen1) and your TAFE NSW password. Click <b>Log In</b>.</p> <p>If prompted, approve the Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) request on your device that has been previously configured for MFA.</p>	
<p>Once the sign in process has completed, you will be presented with the <b>Home</b> tab of the <b>Creative Cloud Desktop</b> application.</p> <p>You can minimise or close this window.</p>
