



# AMEP Pathways to Employment Program (PEP) Course Information Sessions

The Pathways to Employment Program (PEP) offers **free**<sup>^</sup> courses that will develop your employability and language skills. These courses will also introduce you to the Australian work culture and how to participate in the workplace effectively.

All courses include a 40 hour skilled-based, entry level work experience placement. Some skill based courses also provide you with a Statement of Attainment.

## To be eligible for PEP, you must:

- be currently enrolled in AMEP or attended in the last 12 months
- have language skills to participate in a workplace
- be ready to work or go on to further studies
- be able to obtain a Working with Children Check and/or police check (when required)
- be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (for some courses)
